Introduction

Prompt jobs are a way to interact with a customer or an individual that is using the terminal. By using this feature you are able to display messages, questions and confirmations on the terminal.

Overview

- 1. Make POST call to create a new prompt job.
- 2. Make GET call to display a specific prompt job.
- 3. Make GET call to list all prompt jobs for an organization
- 4. Make PUT call to cancel a specific prompt job.

Verb: POST

Required Parameters:

- serial_number= The serial number of the terminal. Use only serial_number or client_id, not both.
- client_id= The client_id of client associated to the terminal. Use only serial_number or client_id, not both.
- type= The type of the prompt job. Allowed values "yes/no", "ok/cancel", "signature"
- message= The message that needs to be displayed on the terminal. Limit should be 50 for "yes/no", 200 for "ok/cancel" and 255 otherwise

Recommended Parameters:

One of the three URLs where Transaction Broker will POST to when a prompt job is finalized by the terminal. This eliminates the need
for polling for the job's status. Only HTTPS URLs are allowed. The callback will the callback will retry if the host is unresponsive. The
response received from the callback url must have the response code 2xx. Basic auth credentials may be added in to url ie.
'https://username:password@address.com' or as an url param 'https://address.com?token=secret'.
